2. **All dancers must present a 2011 Registration card to compete.**
3. Age groups are determined by the number of dancers competing and are subject to change without notice.
4. Dancers may only compete in one category.
5. Age as of September 3, 2011 applies. Proof of age must be furnished, if requested.
6. Pre-registration is required. No field entries EXCEPT for Special Event C.
7. The judge's decisions are final.
8. Number of places awarded at the judge's discretion.
9. Trophies awarded to the highest aggregate point winner in each age group for Beginner through Premier levels; Most Promising Dancer award(s) given at the judge's discretion.
10. Competitors must be ready to perform when event or number is called to avoid disqualification from that event.
11. Competitors must remain in complete costume until all medals and trophies in their category have been awarded.
12. The HSHF Board reserves the right to make changes to schedule of events.

RULES for SPECIAL EVENTS

A & B: Choreography

Dancers must enter and compete in regular competition to compete in choreography event(s).

- ◆ Choreography must be original. Group choreography should not exceed 3 minutes; solo choreography should not exceed 2.5 minutes including on/off.
- ◆ Music, choreography, and costume must be in good taste and should to some degree reflect Scottish/Celtic heritage.
- ◆ Pre-Premier Duets may be comprised of either:

Dancers at the same level, i.e. *all* Beginner, *all* Novice, or *all* Intermediate OR in combined Pre-Premier levels of Beginner Novice & Intermediate.
