Dancers may only compete in one group. (a group is 3 or more dancers)

Registration must include a list of team members and their registration numbers on a separate sheet of paper.

Provide your own music, which must have a **CELTIC THEME and CELTIC COSTUME, limited to 3 minutes.** (Performances will be timed.

DISQUALIFICATION for exceeding the time limit).

Group and Solo Choreography will take place at the Riverside Adventure Center after the awards for the National Dances have been presented.

On-line entries close at 12:00 pm August 21, 2011.

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Dance Committee and will incur a double entry fee, which must be paid via credit card. Tickets will be held and must be picked up at Will Call. No parking pass will be issued.

No telephone entries or field entries will be accepted.

PARKING IS LIMITED and Parking passes will be distributed on a first come-first served basis.

HIGHLAND DANCING RULES:

- Competition will conform to **SOBHD RULES.**
- Please bring 2011 SOBHD Registration card when registering.
- Age will be computed as of the day before the competition.
- All judges' decisions are final.
- If there are not 6 dancers in a Championship age group, that group will be combined with the next age group to qualify as a Championship.
- Dancers must be prepared to fill in for the Reel.
- The Games' Organization reserves the right to remove from the schedule and/or make any changes recommended by the Judges or the Highland Dancing Committee, so long as their actions are in the best interest of the competition.
- Competitors must remain in dancing attire until all medals and trophies have been awarded.
