RULES AND PROCEDURES

1. The Highland Dance Competition will conform to S.O.B.H.D. rules and standards.
2. Dancers are required to have a 2011 S.O.B.H.D. registration card *on-site* – registration accepted with 2010 number if card is pending.
3. Dancers will compete in age groups according to their age on February 19, 2011.
4. The competition committee reserves the right to combine or divide classes depending upon entries received.
5. Dancers entering the competition first will dance last.
6. The decisions of the judge are final.
7. Communication with the judge or piper regarding the competition, by competitor or other interested parties, is forbidden and may disqualify a competitor.
8. Dancers must be ready and appear when called. Dancers failing to do so will forfeit their chance to dance in that event.
9. Dancers must be in costume to receive awards.
10. Medals and trophies for morning events will be awarded prior to lunch; those for afternoon events will be awarded at the end of the competition.
11. Field entries will **not** be accepted.
12. Protests must be made in writing to the competition organizer on the day of the competition, accompanied by a \$25.00 US cash fee. The fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

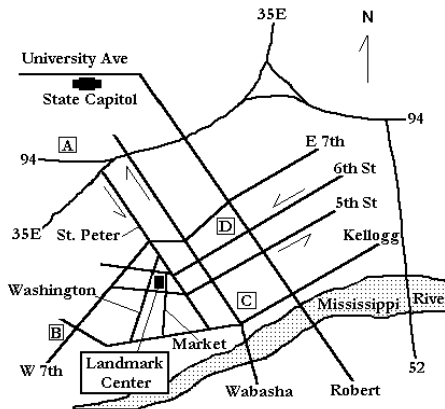
